Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) are the leading cause of death and disease burden worldwide, accounting for 41 million deaths each year, which is equivalent to 71% of all deaths globally.¹ According to the data released by the World Health Organization (WHO) in 2018, NCDs account for about 91% of all deaths in Ireland.² Approximately 1 million people in Ireland today are living with chronic diseases including Diabetes, Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD), Asthma or Cardiovascular disease.³ The Irish longitudinal study on ageing, TILDA, reports that 64.8% of people over 65 age live with two or more chronic diseases.⁴
